ANNOUNCEMENT OF 2017 ECNS AWARDS WINNERS

ECNS is pleased to honor and acknowledge outstanding contributors and distinguished researchers in the field of Clinical Electrophysiology and Neuroimaging through its awards program.

Awards Winners for 2017, which will be presented at the BACI conference in Bern, are detailed below.

Career Contribution Award: This award is for senior scientists whose work has been influential in the field of Electrophysiology and Neuroimaging and has had high impact on research and clinical applications. Any scientist may be nominated by any member of ECNS. This award is considered the highest honor bestowed by the ECNS.

Awardee:



Erol Başar, Ph.D., Director Istanbul Kultur University Brain Dynamics and Cognition Research Center, Istanbul, Turkey. Erol Başar is one of the pioneers emphasizing the importance of oscillatory brain dynamics for integrative brain function and memory since the 1970s. He has published 18 books, over 200 other publications and 6 international conferences. His work has influenced the conceptualization and investigation of brain rhythms.

As per tradition, ECNS will ask one of his students to give a presentation highlighting the life work of the awardee.

Roy John Award: This award is for a scientist who has produced more than 50 articles that are indexed in the SCI. Any scientist may be nominated by any member of ECNS.

Awardee:



Dean F. Salisbury, Associate Professor of Psychiatry, Director of the Clinical Neurophysiology Research Laboratory, Department of Psychiatry, University of Pittsburgh. He earned his doctorate degree in Biological Psychology at the State University of New York at Stony Brook and completed a clinical research training fellowship focusing in Neuropsychiatry at the Harvard Medical School. Dr Salisbury spent 22 years at Harvard Medical School studying the neurophysiology of psychosis, and has been performing EEG/MEG/MRI multimodal imaging at the University of Pittsburgh since 2012.

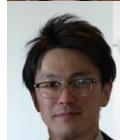
The awardee will give the E. Roy John Memorial lecture and will receive \$1000.
